Parent Information & Camp Policies

Sick Child Policy

AMAC follows the state guidelines for sick children. According to the state licensing manual, "when a child runs a temperature of 101.00 degrees or more has reoccurring vomiting or diarrhea (twice in the same day) the parent will be notified and arrangements will be made for the child to leave the center as soon as possible.

Arrival and Departure of Children

All children are greeted warmly upon arrival at the center. Staff member will mark children's attendance as they enter the building for the AMAC Camp Program. All children must be signed out at the end of the day. Parents are required to walk their child into the building each morning during camp programs.

Children may be released only to their parents or to the authorized persons noted in child's file. A child WILL NOT be released if we do not know the person picking up the child or if we have not been notified by the child's parent, in person, that an individual has permission to pick up the child.

Late Pickup of Children

If a child has not been picked up by 6:30pm and a parent has not contacted the center, the following procedures shall be initiated:

- 1. We will attempt to reach the parent/guardians. If a parent/guardian cannot be reached...
2. We will attempt to contact emergency contacts. If they cannot be reached...

Transportation Policy

Only children enrolled in AMAC Camp Program can be transported on our vehicles. All children and staff must use a seat belt. Only one person may be strapped into each belt. A Staff member is responsible for verifying that all children are wearing their seat belt properly, and that the door is secured.

Pool Regulations

Children must pass a proficiency test to go in water over their shoulders. Any child who does not swim in designated area based on their swim level will not be allowed in the pool. Water safety is #1 priority..

Food Policy

It is recommended that lunches and snacks brought from home be nutritious and nonperishable and packed in a soft cooler/lunch bag with ice pack. Please label food container with the date and child's name. AMAC does not provide lunches except for pool day. On pool day AMAC will provide 2 slices of pizza and 1 Capri Sun.

Behavior Management & Disciplinary Actions

If a child brings a weapon to camp, intentionally harms others, vandalizes property, or displays other extreme behavior, he/she will be dismissed from the camp and no refund will be given. For inappropriate behavior, parents will be notified verbally and/or in writing with notification of further action.

All participants enrolled in AMAC Summer Camp must meet the code of conduct which states children must be able to demonstrate the following with minimal direction: (1) must be able to maintain personal care without staff support; (2) stay with assigned group; (3) respect others (listen, follow directions, use appropriate language, keep hands to oneself; (4) maintain self control.

Policy for Storing and Administering Medications

AMAC will administer only prescription medications, which are in the original container and accompanied by a medicine fact sheet. All medications are administered at 12 noon unless noted by a physician. Medications are stored in the office in a LOCKED box. There are separate locked containers for refrigerated medications. Only the AMAC management will administer medication.

For over the counter medications AMAC will only follow the directions on the bottle, unless a doctor's note is present.

In order for the child to receive medication while at AMAC, the parent must complete a Medication Authorization form. Forms for medication administration will only be valid for 5 days. A new form must be completed each week for as long as the child requires the medication. All medication will need to be accompanied by the side affect sheet given by the doctor. All medication will be sent home when the medication authorization forms expires.

Tuition and Other Fees

Tuition is due based on terms agreed upon in the contract signed when enrolled into AMAC Camp Program. AMAC Camp Program can accept payments using a check, Visa, Master Card or cash. If checks or credit card payments are returned or declined, families will be expected to pay any charges incurred.

Refund/Cancellation/Week Transfers

A \$65.00 cancellation fee will apply to each cancellation that is initiated. (i.e. cancel one week \$65.00, later cancel another week- another \$65.00 fee is applied).

Weeks changed after June 15th a \$15.00 fee will apply to each change that is initiated. Please note that we can not guarantee a spot will be available in the week/weeks that you want to change to.

Promotional Photos/Videos

Children enrolled in AMAC Camp programs may be photographed or videotaped during camp by AMAC for AMAC promotional purposes unless a separate written request not to photograph or videotape is submitted to AMAC.
